We were all shocked and saddened to hear that on January 1st, the life of a young boy was taken. On January 24<sup>th</sup>, another young man's life was cut short at a Cut Creator Barbershop. These two incidents have left many of us really concerned about safety in our community.

The purpose of this meeting is for our residents to hear from Senior Staff of Toronto Police Service-42 Division, Crime Prevention Association of Toronto (CPAT) and leaders from various faith communities who will be attending to share their thoughts and advise us about community safety. Followed by the meeting we will be holding a candle light vigil rallying outside the mall (weather permitting) as our sign of respect for the two victims who lost their lives in the shooting.

A strong and united community can overcome and withstand the hardest of situations. We have wonderful neighbourhoods and I hope we can stand firm against crime and violence while restoring solidarity and peace. Let us all remain hopeful and work together to keep our community safe, unified, stable, vibrant and strong.
